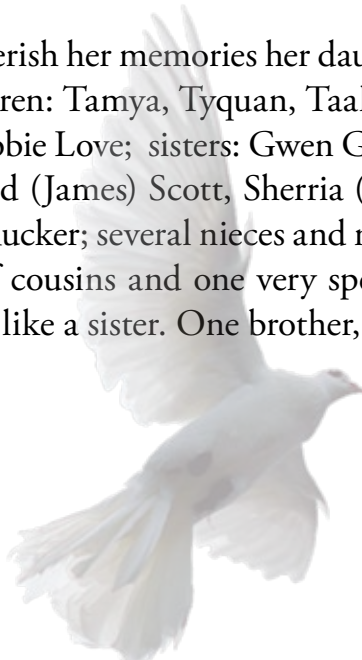
# Obituary
