
Obituary

Monzolia grew up in Hinds County, Mississippi and graduated from Sumner Hill High School in Clinton, Mississippi. She attended Okolona Junior College and Millsaps College. In 1965, she married Mr. Thomas James Course and to this union three lovely children, Thomas James Course, Jr., Beverly Course Jackson and Kimberly Lynn Course, were born. She was employed at Delphi/Packard Electric as an auditor until her retirement in 2001.

She accepted Christ at an early age and she and her family united with Pleasant Gift Missionary Baptist Church in Jackson, Mississippi. She later joined New Life Fellowship Baptist Church in Jackson, Mississippi. At the time of her death, she was a member of Making Jesus Real Church in Pearl, Mississippi. She was dedicated and committed



in her service for Christ. She served on various church committees and auxiliaries throughout her lifetime. Monzolia will be remembered most for her powerful, mesmerizing and melodious singing voice.

Monzolia became ill in early 2006, but she kept going and doing. Throughout her tribulations, she continued to inspire those around her with her wisdom, humor, loving-kindness and mostly her strength and faith in God. Although she was ill, she never complained. She continued to support her children, grandchildren and family and friends in any way that she was needed. She fought her illness with courage and a cheerful spirit until her last day. On Friday, January 30, 2009, she yielded her spirit unto God and entered into a place of eternal rest and peace; God decided that another angel was needed for duty. Her ever-present smile and radiant personality will be long remembered.
